What are Fair Shares?

Fair Shares are a donation. They are a simple, meaningful way for people to support Crafted Earth Studios and feel part of our creative community, helping neuro disabled makers continue to grow their skills, creativity and confidence. It's about sharing in the success of Crafted Earth Studios, where everyone can play a small part in helping creativity and opportunity grow.

Fair Shares are symbolic, not financial:

These are not investments and have no financial value. They do not give ownership, dividends or voting rights. They are a donation.

What do you receive when you donate?

Supporters will receive: a digital certificate, email updates from the studios and invites to two open days a year.

Suggested donation:

We suggest a minimum donation of £20, representing 20 symbolic shares at £1 each, but supporters are welcome to give more or less if they wish.

Support goes directly to Crafted Earth Studios:

Donations help fund creative workshops, materials and equipment.





What could my Fair Shares support?

Weaving:

- Equipment such as a tabletop loom
- Specialist tools like a bobbin winder
- Materials used throughout the year for weaving projects

Woodcraft:

- Essential materials including paints, varnishes, oils and resins used to finish products

Fibrecraft:

- Merino wool, felting tools and equipment used in workshops
- Specialist equipment such as hand carders
- Storage and practical resources that help keep workshops running
